### THE ACADEMIC PROGRAM

- Students may take up to three online courses, which have been approved for Marist credit.
- Students enrolled in a Greystone course enjoy full Marist College library and eLearning access.

- BIOL 101 L721: Topics in Biology – 3 credits: 10 week course
- BIOL 225 L721: Topics in Nutrition – 3 credits: 10 week course
- CSIS 103 L721: Intro. to Information and Computer Literacy – 3 credits: 10 week course (**requires Microsoft Office 2007 Professional software**)
- ENG 117 L721: College Writing II – 3 credits: 10 week course
- ENG 210 L721: American Literature I – 3 credits: 10 week course
- ENG 255 L721: Introduction to Literature – 3 credits: 10 week course
- ENSC 101 L721: Intro. To Environmental Issues – 3 credits: 10 week course
- HIST 101L721: Themes in Modern History – 3 credits: 10 week course
- HIST 228L721: America Since 1945 – 3 credits: 10 week course
- MATH 130 L721: Introduction to Statistics – 3 credits: 10 week course
- PHIL101L721: Introduction to Philosophy – 3 credits: 10 week course
- PHIL 103L721: World Views and Values – 3 credits: 10 week course
- PSYC 101L721: Introduction to Psychology – 3 credits: 10 week course
- REST 107L721: Introduction to Religion – 3 credits: 10 week course

### REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

- Students registering for college courses must fulfill criteria established for the course including any pre-requisite courses.
- Student must be a high school junior or senior.
- Students must have written approval from their parents and school guidance counselor to participate in the program.

## **APPLICATION TO PROJECT GREYSTONE:**

- Complete a Marist College application form, available in the high school guidance office, have it signed by the student's parent, and **RETURN IT TO THE GUIDANCE OFFICE. DO NOT SEND THE FORM TO MARIST. REGISTRATION FOR COURSES:**
- Registration for courses occurs after the administrative processing of applications.
- The registering process is done at the high school.
- Only a school guidance counselor or teacher can register the student through the school Greystone portal.
- Alternatively, students can fill out an application form and have it signed by their parent and guidance counselor. The guidance counselor can then fax the application to Ms. Ann Marie Roberts at 845-575-3605.
- Once the form is submitted, the student sends a check made out to Marist College (\$399 for each course).
- Checks should be **mailed to Ms. Ann Roberts, Lowell Thomas 109, Marist College, Poughkeepsie, NY 12601.**

## **TRAINING FOR eLEARNING COURSES:**

- The first time a student registers for an online course they are required to attend a training session on using the online eLearning environment.

## **TRANSCRIPT:**

- Students will receive a grade from their instructor who will submit it to Marist College.
- Transcripts of school/college courses may be requested from the Marist Registrar. This can be done by accessing the Marist web page and clicking on the Registrar's site.
